

Do you live in, have you ever lived in or visited Market Drayton and walked/ridden around the **Woodseaves** area, particularly **Hollins Lane**, between **1996 and 2016**?

If so, we need your help!



Background

In 2016, conscious that the described route does not appear on official maps as a recognised public right of way and that the landowner was developing over the Hollins Lane and blocking off all access, Sutton upon Tern Parish Council lodged an official claim with Shropshire Council to have this route legally recognised. This will protect it for future use and ensure the landowner provides a suitable diversion route if necessary.

What the Parish Council is doing now

The Parish Council feels that the case for this route being recognised is strong. Unfortunately Shropshire Council has not taken any action on this claim. As such, the Parish Council intends to appeal to the Planning Inspectorate to have this claim reviewed. This process provides a brief opportunity to submit new/further evidence.

How you can help

In order to secure this route for future generations, we URGENTLY need EVERYONE who has ever used this route (you, members of your household, relatives, friends, neighbours, those who have since moved away) especially between 1996 and 2016 and wish to do so again, to complete a user statement.

This statement covers the route used, the years it was used and whether or not its use was effectively 'as of right'.

In addition photographs of the route being used or any other documentary evidence or would be really useful.

If the appeal is lost there will be no opportunity to revisit the subject, so please don't delay ACT TODAY!
